This year started off with both the Somerset Gazette and BBC Radio Somerset picking up our release about the Creative Coverage Mixed Exhibition at The Brewhouse in Taunton. Pleasingly they gave a good amount of space to the story, which helped generate excellent levels of sales for the exhibitors, particularly Peter Hayes, whose ceramics sold well. This success has no doubt helped with the venue inviting us back for a second show at the start of 2017, which is great news.

Pretty much every month Caroline's In Conversation articles are published in *The Artist* magazine. Subjects of her interviews during 2016 have included Lynda Kettle RBSA, Sylvia Paul and Rachel Fenner. Caroline is on her knees writing in between feeding little Henry and juggling our bookkeeping as well as all the other tasks a mother must tackle. She does

this with aplomb. That's not to mention packing our belongings to move house and organising plumbers for our recent central heating overhaul.

We have enjoyed plenty of local coverage across the country for a great many of our members from the Blackmore Vale and BBC Radio Solent for L. Paul Matthews through to the Portsmouth News for Colin Merrin, the Maldon and Burnham Standard for Sylvia Paul and Pembrokeshire Life for Austen Pinkerton. National coverage was generated for Edward Waites in The Irish Field and international coverage in the Saudi Gazette and Artweek for Lesley Birch.

More recently a press release that we submitted for Sara Barnes secured her a good amount of coverage in the *Romsey Advertiser* weekly newspaper (pictured). "Just perfect to have my name in lights before Windsor," says Sara. "So thank you Creative Coverage."

Prior to Sarah MacDonald's photographic exhibition at Ardross Farm Shop in Elie, Scotland, we had submitted a press release and Sarah asked us to also invite the media to the event. Our efforts resulted in a photographer from the *Dundee Courier* attending and an article was published in the paper.

Sculptor Nikki Taylor was keen for us to generate press coverage about her commission from pop group Bastille. We have already got her into the Sunday Independent and the West Briton.
